

2009 INFLUENZA VACCINATION CLINICS (SEASONAL FLU)

The Rock Island County Health Department is encouraging Rock Island County residents who are at risk of developing complication to the flu to receive a flu shot. The recommendations from CDC of people who are eligible to receive a flu shot are:

- Persons aged 50 or above
- Children ages 6 months to 59 months
- Adults and Children with respiratory, heart disease or other chronic disease
- Pregnant women'
- Residents of long-term care facilities
- Children ages 6 mos to 18yrs of age who are on long-term aspirin therapy
- Health care workers
- Out-of-home caregivers and household contacts of children age 0-59 months of age

As in past years, there is no charge to those with Medicare Part B. Please let us know if your Medicare Part B is Federal Medicare or Aetna, Humana, AARP, or any other plan. Please bring all Medicare cards with you.

Flu shots are \$30 and pneumonia shots are \$45. (Guidelines from CDC for pneumonia are 1 shot before age 65, and 1 shot after age 65).
